Description: This workshop is designed for curriculum specialists, curriculum supervisors, and teacher leaders to acquaint them with the content and organization of the new Common Core State Standards in English Language Arts and mathematics. Using a standards deconstructing process, participants will examine the Common Core State Standards with respect to the concepts and skills, big ideas, and essential questions that they address. Participants will also investigate the alignment between the intended curriculum (what the standards require), the operational curriculum (what teachers teach), and the assessed curriculum (what the state tests).

Skills/Observable Outcomes: Participants will be familiar with the content and organization of the Common Core Standards, including the College & Career Readiness Anchor Standards, and how these standards impact literacy and/or math instruction.
